
Property Description

Two expansive floors of office space for lease in the Dartmouth Professional Centre at 277 Pleasant Street. A total of 18,736 sf is available on the third and fourth floors, each suite offering a mix of private offices, open office space and a number of common areas.

The 77,815 sf professional office building is currently 89% leased and anchored by the Province of Nova Scotia through various court services and judicial departments. The building itself has seen a comprehensive maintenance and renovation program in recent years with over \$2.7 million in capital upgrades completed since 2018 and an additional \$2.8 million committed for enhancements to tenant areas.

Location Description

The Dartmouth Professional Centre at 277 Pleasant Street is conveniently located on a 2.51-acre corner site with prominent frontage on Pleasant Street and Acadia Street, within a well-established commercial, civic and residential node that is within a 15-minute drive of Downtown Halifax.

The location benefits from significant residential and commercial growth in the immediate area, including the \$150-million expansion and renovation of Dartmouth General Hospital and the continued densification of NSCC's Ivany Campus, which includes a new student housing complex slated for completion in 2025.
